### **Mainroad and MOTI Donate New NorthStar Trail Parking Area**

**Cranbrook, BC (October 21, 2011)** – Mainroad East Kootenay Contracting Limited and the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure have partnered to improve public accessibility to the NorthStar Trail between the City of Cranbrook and Kimberley.

Both groups were looking for a project to help enhance the communities that they serve. They determined that providing a parking lot to provide additional safe public access to the NorthStar Trail, next to the entrance to Shadow Mountain on Wycliffe Road, was just that project.
