Mainroad Lower Mainland Contracting makes Critter Care dreams come true.

Surrey, BC, December 1, 2011 - The Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure and Mainroad Lower Mainland Contracting teamed together to participate in a community partnership project supporting Langley based Critter Care Wildlife Society. The Community Partnership Program is a new initiative this year combining the resources of road building contractors and the Ministry.

“All of Critter Care’s volunteers and staff work so hard to save animals impacted by human activities in the Lower Mainland. It was an easy decision to select Critter Care as our project for the program.” says Réal Charrois, General Manager of Mainroad Lower Mainland Contracting.

Critter Care Wildlife Society specializes in the treatment, care and release of sick, injured and orphaned Native Mammal species of British Columbia's Southern and Lower Mainland. They are the only facility in BC specializing in the care of mammals and one of only four Bear Rehab facilities in the province. In addition to rehabilitation, Critter Care is involved in community based education programs. Critter Care is principally volunteer driven and depends solely on the support of the public.

The project consisted of building a roof over Critter Care’s triage centre and constructing a new rodent free food storage facility. The fawn cage was expanded, new floor tile was installed in the skunk nursery, and a canopy was erected over the entrance to Critter Care’s intern building. Other small jobs included upgrading pathways around cages using concrete slabs donated by Abbotsford Concrete and painting door trim. Ministry and Mainroad volunteers donated their time, materials and equipment on Saturday, October 22nd to complete the new structures and repairs.

Noel Mankey, Vice President, Operations for Mainroad Group noted, *“Over its 23 year history, Mainroad has given a lot back to the BC community. This was a special project for us - we are very proud of the end result which we know will make a difference to Critter Care.
